

Park House

Park House is the home to TU Dublin's temporary library which will serve the campus until the completion of the Academic Hub in 2023. The building itself has seven floors plus a basement and three of those floors are now dedicated to the library along with a portion of the basement for storage. This area of Park House is also the temporary home to our Academic Writing Centre, Careers Development Centre, Disability Support Centre, and Maths Learning Centre.

Park House was originally built in 1972 to be used as a hotel but it was subsequently redeveloped as office space. Several of the upper floors have been refurbished and continue to be used as office space for TU Dublin staff, postgraduate students, and various external tenants. The library floors were extensively refurbished and redesigned in 2020 to offer a modern, bright, and open space to enhance the learning experience for the university's students. On the ground floor there is a café while the top floor features a staff canteen.
