

Volunteering experience on your CV

Ensure to include all your volunteer experience because it:

- Shows initiative that you got involved in extra-curricular activity
- Demonstrates drive, commitment and discipline
- Demonstrates your commitment to making a positive impact in the world
- Allows you to demonstrate how you have developed soft skills
- Can allow you to fill a gap in your CV

Volunteering experience in your interviews

- Use your volunteer experience to show your experience in your chosen career path
- Include any leadership roles you have held or demonstrate proactiveness and initiative in your volunteer work
- Use your volunteer experience to show your soft skills.
- These include traits like integrity, flexibility and empathy, adaptability and creativity.
- Most importantly be able to describe specific situations & examples

 if you're new to the workforce or changing careers.




Volunteering ABROAD/ INTERNATIONAL Volunteering

Volunteering ABROAD/ INTERNATIONAL Volunteering

- International volunteering can be:
- Short term (2 weeks 3 months)
- Medium term (3-6 months)
- Long term (1 2 years)
- Sending organisations may be:
- Not for profit: charities, NGOs, governmental organisations or programmes.
- For profit: travel companies, adventure companies
