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ACCESS TO APPRENTICESHIP

Are you aged between 16 and 24 and living in Dublin? Would you like to find out more about apprenticeships?

TU Dublin - City Campus is delivering an innovative educational programme which provides a stepping stone for young people who are interested in apprenticeships.

Who is the Access to Apprenticeship Programme for?

The course is aimed at young men and women aged between 16 and 24 living in Dublin who experience social and economic barriers to work and/or education.

When?

The programme runs 3 times a year September, January and April.

Where?

TU Dublin - City Campus Bolton Street and work placement locations.

How many weeks?

Full-time for 12 weeks, including the last two weeks on work placement.

What does the course cover?

Topics covered will include:

- Sampling a range of apprenticeships in; Construction, Engineering, Electrical and Motor & Aviation Industries
- New apprenticeships
- Preparing your CV and Interview Skills
- Two weeks work placement
- Health & Safety and Safe Pass Certificates

Do I need to have any qualifications?

Applicants must be at least 16 years of age and have a minimum of grade D in five subjects in the Junior Certificate or the equivalent. Employers may require additional minimum qualifications. There is access criteria to satisfy see details in the application form.

Is there a cost?

The course is free.
