#### What is I2LATAM?

Erasmus+ I2LATAM is an international cooperation project that aims at strengthening research and innovation strategic management capacities in young Latin American universities, boosting their potential for engaging with local and regional actors, both public and private. The project also seeks to foster and harness collaboration between Latin American and European institutions to develop joint initiatives.



This project is inspired by the European Union's Smart Specialization Strategies (RIS3).

### Who can participate?

I2LATAM seeks to engage researchers, R&D managers, higher educations institutions, local and national government agencies, chambers of commerce and companies, in initiatives that promote sustainable development of their territories.

Training university staff on tools and practices that enable them to work collaboratively with other actors in the environment.
