

MSc SPATIAL PLANNING

MSc Spatial Planning is a 2.5 year part-time programme aimed at experienced professionals working in the built environment who wish to become competent in the practice of planning and obtain a professionally recognised planning degree.

The multi-disciplinary environment fosters a creative atmosphere of interactive, problem-based learning. Teaching takes place in boardroom-style symposia and students are set real-life projects often involving actual problems facing planning agencies.

The course if the only part-time course accredited by both the the Irish Planning Institute and the Royal Town Planning Institute and has an active alumni, the Spatial Planning Graduate Network.

Course Content & Delivery

Entry Requirements

Candidates are interviewed and should have a minimum of five years relevant experience in a professional capacity, an appropriate honours degree (2.2 grade or higher) and an ability to demonstrate professional activity that is relevant to spatial planning.
